CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Student-Teachers enrolled at Poojya Sane Guruji Vidya Prasark Mandal's College of Education, Shahada must recognize their responsibilities to this Institution, to the teacher-educators and to the officials bearing in mind the prestige and the reputation of the institution. Failure to maintain appropriate standards of conduct will attract disciplinary action.

RULES OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

Students are required to maintain regular attendance to be eligible for appearing in the University Examination. They should follow the parameters given below:

1. A student-teacher must have 80% of attendance in Theory(TH) classes and 90% attendance in Practical work classes in each course for appearing the final Examinations.
2. Student-Teachers who have below 80% attendance of total classes are not eligible to appear for the final Examinations.
3. If a student-teacher is absent for more than two weeks without prior permission / intimation of the principal, his / her name is likely to be struck of the register.

All Student-Teachers must be in their classes and take their seats at the beginning of each lecture. They must not enter or leave the Class-Room without permission.

Student-Teachers should not possess mobile phones or any other electronic device for communication in the Class-Rooms / Seminar-Halls / Examination Halls / Library / Study-Room / any other place of academic interest within the College. It is prohibited and is liable for punishment.

1. Resorting to any kind of malpractice (copying, impersonation, use of unfair means, exchanging answer-sheets) during examinations will not be tolerated and it is punishable offence.
2. Student-Teachers are required to check the Notice Board (both Offline & Online) for important announcements in regular basis. Rules for the conduct of examinations placed on the Notice Board must be strictly observed. No excuse will be considered if Notices on the Board are ignored.

3. All student – teachers are to participate in the various co-curricular activities of the Institution.
4. Students must refrain from mishandling and tampering with library books or college computer systems.
5. Student –Teachers are forbidden from inviting friends from other institutions and outsiders to the College.
6. No posters are to be pasted or fixed with cello-tape anywhere on the College Building / walls. Any writing, scribbling on the walls will attract disciplinary measures against the student-teachers.
7. The right to access Girl's Common Room and Ladies Toilet is reserved to only Women/ Girls` Student-Teachers
8. Smoking, chewing tobacco products, playing cards, spitting and loitering are strictly prohibited inside the College and Hostel Campus and shall invite severe punishment/disciplinary action.
9. A student shall not commit or cause breach of peace inside and around the College campus.
10. Student-Teachers are expected to treat the members of the staff both teaching and non-teaching with courtesy both in and outside the College. Students shall not, by their act or conduct, cause damage to the reputation of the institution.

Anti-ragging Rules:

We are guided by the Supreme Court and University Grants Commission advocated guidelines for curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions (Regulation–2013). Student-Teachers are required to adhere to the anti-ragging rules that are in force in the campus.

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. Disciplinary action will be taken against those who violate this rule.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL CONCERNED

[Student-Teachers, Teacher-Educator & Librarian, Non-Teaching Staff]

1. No Political Motive can be used.
2. Any Gender-Discriminatory behavior will be treated as a crime.
3. Negative attitude towards the Physically Challenged (Diyangya) cannot be shown.
4. No one can be despised because of race or caste (S.T., S.C etc.).
5. No one can be abused for any excuse. Attacking others and/or being reckless and/or shouting and/or obstructing the conduct of a meeting and/or making a personal attack is a punishable offence.
6. The Institutions is committed to society for implementation of a 'ZeroTolerance Policy towards sexual harassment' and maintenance of a campus free from discrimination, harassment, retaliation, or sexual assault at all levels.
7. It is strictly forbidden for any one to take, carry, exchange, or collect all kinds of drugs of the college premises. The college premises are a smoking free zone, please respect it.
8. Avoid Conflict of Self-Interest: Clash of personal interest with professional activity can lead to potential clash of interest in diverse activities
9. Denial of authority and/or Conspiring against the authorities and/or defying the authorities and / or disrespecting the authorities will be considered as a punishable offence.
